Join us to hear from this panel of amazing executive women leaders in predominately male-dominated industries and how they rose to their distinguished positions within our community.



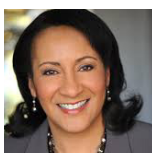

Chief Williams oversees a staff of nearly 4,000 employees and manages an annual budget that exceeds \$600 million. Chief Williams is a 30-year law enforcement veteran and an accomplished police executive. Under her leadership, the Phoenix Police Department is advancing a number of progressive strategies essential in contemporary law enforcement.
